

Impact100 Louisville Announces 2025 BIG REVEAL

Community of Women Collectively Will Donate Over \$3 Million to Benefit Local Nonprofits

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (June 18, 2025) — Impact100 Louisville announced that it will donate \$530,000 to nonprofit organizations in Jefferson County in 2025. The announcement was made during the group's annual "BIG REVEAL" event on June 17, 2025, held this year at TEN20 Craft Brewery. The Louisville chapter revealed its 2025 membership total of 530, which translates to 5 \$100,000 grants and \$30,000 in merit grants to be awarded later this year. With this year's commitment, Impact100 Louisville's current and former members will have donated a total of \$2,588,000 to local nonprofits in just six years.

The Impact100 model of collective giving is simple and effective - 100 women (or more) each donate \$1,000 to create a \$100,000 Impact Grant for a nonprofit organization in their community. After a detailed screening process, the full membership of Impact100 Louisville votes for the final grant recipients which are announced at the organization's annual meeting in November. Impact Grants are awarded for capacity building, program support, and innovation.

Co-founded in 2020 by mother-daughter duo Dani Kannapell and Carey Goldstein, the Louisville chapter of Impact100 was launched in 2020 with the mission of creating *A Community of Women Transforming Lives Through Collective Giving*. According to Goldstein, "Women have the power to transform their communities by coming together collectively and collaboratively. When you give a \$1,000, you hope it makes an impact; when you give a \$1,000 through Impact100 Louisville, you know it will make a significant impact to our community."

Since its founding, Impact100 Louisville has been one of the fastest growing Impact100 chapters in the nation:

- In 2020, 206 members donated \$206,000
- In 2021, 315 members donated \$315,000
- In 2022, 450 members donated \$450,000
- In 2023, 558 members donated \$558,000
- In 2024, 529 members donated \$529,000
- In 2025, 530 members will donate \$530,000 in November to local nonprofits.

"This year represents another incredible milestone for Impact100 Louisville as we surpass the \$3 million mark in total grants awarded to date," said Kannapell. "We could not be more excited that in just six years, we will have contributed more than \$3 million to the local nonprofit community. That's truly making an Impact."

For 2025, Impact100 Louisville received 147 letters of intent and has invited 36 organizations to submit full grant applications. Grant recipients will be announced at the Impact100 Louisville Annual Meeting and Awards Event, scheduled for November 10 at The Olmsted.

Impact100 Louisville is just one of over 70 chapters of Impact100. Collectively, Impact100 Global has awarded nearly \$160 million since granting its first Impact Awards in 2002.
