Impact100 Louisville Now Accepting Letters of Intent and New Members

Women Transforming Lives Through Collective Giving

Louisville, KY - Impact100 Louisville is proud to announce that it will be accepting Letters of Intent (LOI) from March 1 to March 29, 2024. The Louisville chapter of Impact100, founded by mother and daughter Dani Kannapell and Carey Goldstein, came to fruition in 2020 with the mission of creating *A Community of Women Transforming Lives Through Collective Giving*.

The Impact100 model of collective giving is simple and effective - 100 women (or more) each donate \$1,000 to create a \$100,000 Impact Grant for a nonprofit organization in their community. Each November, members vote to identify which nonprofit organization will receive a donation. In just four (4) years, **Impact100 Louisville has donated \$1,529,000** to the local nonprofit community.

This opportunity is open to ALL qualified nonprofit organizations within Jefferson County, Kentucky who are seeking funding in one of the five (5) focus areas:

- Arts and Culture
- Education
- Environment, Recreation, or Preservation
- Family
- Health and Wellness

The types of grant funding that will be considered are Capacity Building, Program Support, and Innovation. Interested applicants are welcome to attend a **Q&A session on March 6 at 10 AM**. In addition to accepting Letters of Intent, the organization is now accepting new members for 2024. Membership enrollment will close on May 31, 2024, and membership fees are tax deductible. Last year a record 558 local women provided \$558,000 in grants to benefit nonprofit organizations. Impact100 Louisville offers various membership interest meetings to discuss the membership model and the direct IMPACT each member makes to the local community.

“Women have the power to transform their communities by coming together collectively and collaboratively. When you give a \$1,000 you hope it makes an impact; however, when you give a \$1,000 through Impact100 Louisville you know it will make a significant impact to our community,” said co-founder Carey Goldstein.
